The sad part on the eve of the meeting was the passing away of the Mother of Sh.Ashok Panigrahi PEX NABM Bhubaneshwar, who continues to be a very valuable member of PSA. The meeting observed a minute of silence to mark the demise of his Mother.

The NEC Meeting wholeheartedly thanked Sh.R.T.Kulkarni formerly PEX CRD Bangaluru for having sponsored a part of the meeting expenditure, eventhough he had left the department under VRS.

The issues discussed in the meeting included the subjects of, DPCs in PEX & IBPS Cadres, ACP & MACP to Programme Cadres, Status of different legal cases, Inclusion of Post 05.10.2007 staff in the Association, Hiring of Consultants in the department, Transfer of the General Secretary to New Delhi, Pending Annual Subscription from Units, Inclusion of Post-1985 DD Productions Assistants in the feeder Cadre for PEX, Special Duty Allowance for those serving in North-Eastern states, and deliberations at State level meetings at Jaipur, Kochi, Bangaluru and Chennai.

The meeting was addressed by Zonal Secretaries / State Secretaries from Andhra Pradesh & Telengana, Tamil Nadu, Kerela, Bihar, West-Bengal, Assam, Gujarat, Odisha, Puducherry, Jharkhand, and New Delhi.

The meeting unanimously decided and passed resolutions as mentioned below,

1. The Association should take all efforts to protect the seniority & promotion prospects of the Parent Cadre of TREX / Equated Cadres and be watchful of any action that shall affect them.
2. The Association should jointly along with other sister Associations take up the case of grant of SDA to those working in the North-Eastern states,
3. **The Association thanked the CEO, Member (Personnel) and DG AIR for taking steps to convene the long pending DPCs in IBPS as directed by the Principal Bench of CAT New Delhi in OA.No.243/2002. It urged them to follow a timeline for completion of the DPCs. The meeting also thanked senior Officers in Prasar Bharati for the communication dated 02.12.2015 to the PAOs on stoppage of recovery on account of MACP.**
4. Members present felt that any new recruitment in the JTS cadre of IBPS should be resorted to only after completing all the pending DPCs.
5. **The meeting unanimously decided to hold a peaceful silent march & Meeting at New Delhi on 11th March 2016 to highlight the stagnation among Programme Cadres. All the members are requested to participate in the March to make it a grand success.**

The Central Executive Committee in its meeting on 1st January decided to give a detailed letter to the AIR Directorate on their circulars dated 04.11.2015 and 15.12.2015. The CEC also urged the members to give their inputs before 20th January, 2016 on the Notification on

Allotment of Residential Quarters issues by Prasar Bharati on 10th December, 2015. It also urged all the Members to send their Annual subscription if not sent already , and to take all efforts to register new members from among the new TREXs and PEXs. The Proforma to be submitted by new members is uploaded as well. **PSA continues to be the largest Association among the Programme Cadres in AIR & DD.**

The Central Unit of the Association wishes to Thank the entire team at AIR Kolkata for having made the meeting a success and and also specially thank the team from Tamil Nadu who had endured a lot problem in reaching Chennai on their way back due to the severe floods at Chennai.
