

## **Information from Central Unit**

02.04.2015

Friends and Colleagues,

The Central Executive Committee of the Association met on 31<sup>st</sup> March and discussed many issues that are agitating the minds of Programme staff all over the country. The points discussed and decisions are summarized below,

1. The Central unit thanked the members for their contributions to the fund of the Association, and in this context thanked State Secretary of Gujarat and the Chennai unit for having mobilized a substantial portion of the fund received till date.
2. The Central Executive Committee thanked all the sister Association's for their joint stand and support on the issue of the show cause notice concerning the Hyderabad case.
3. PSA has been pressing for issuance of adhoc promotion in the JTS cadre and also ratification of the promotion orders issued in February 2014 in the JTS and STS Cadres. This is very important as many of the STS officers are yet to be given the Deputy Director salary. The file is pending approval by DOPT, and is being pursued by the central unit. New promotions in the JTS cadre will be issued only after approval of DOPT of the earlier promotion orders.
4. PSA will also press Prasar Bharati to convene all pending DPC's in the JAG, STS and JTS cadres, as directed by the Hon'ble Principal

Bench of CAT, New Delhi on 24.03.2015 ( OA.No.596/2014). PSA has already given letters to Prasar Bharati for consideration of senior programme staff to vacant IBPS posts on deputation posts.

5. The seniority of the PEX ( in-situ) is an issue which is of utmost importance to PSA. We have been pursuing the Management to divert all the vacant DR posts in the PEX cadre to Promotee vacancies so as to accommodate the PEX in-situ's. Moreover PSA is also pursuing upgradation of the PEX in-situ posts to the PEX Cadre as has been done in the Railway and Finance Ministry. The cadre review proposal is also being pursued by PSA as a way to resolve the severe stagnation in the programme cadres.
6. PSA has also filed a MA for early hearing of the ACP case in the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi. The restarting of the MACP to those who are yet to get the second MACP is also being pursued in the Ministry along with ARTEE. We are trying to resolve the issue once and for all, so as to avoid any recovery in future.
7. The Central Executive committee decided to upload the voter roll of the Association and requests all the Zonal Secretaries, State Secretaries and Unit members to kindly go through it and give a feed back to any of the Central Executive members to stream line the voter roll before declaration of the election schedule. The last date for receipt of the voter roll corrections will be 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2015. All the members are requested to give the exact information on the present posting of each member and their designation, so as to avoid any hitch in the rolls.
