Sir,

This is in continuation of our Association's previous letters on the direction of Hon'ble CAT Delhi in MA.No.2681/2018 in OA 3046/2015 on 26.06.2018.

We wish to bring to your kind attention that all the staff who have retired after 2014 and were beneficiaries of 25.02.99 are troubled by Hon'ble MIB decision of treating these scales as an Upgradation while granting **MACP through letter dated 08.09.2014**. Almost all retiring staff Members who got the replacement scales vide order dated 25.02.99 are being paid their terminal benefits after deducting the amount by treating this scale as an Upgradation and henceforth on an average an amount to the tune of Rs. 5 Lakh to 10 lakh or more is deducted from their terminal benefits.

The order of CAT Delhi on a similar issue was challenged by another sister Association in the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi (WP-C. No.9890 / 2019, where another stay was granted against the order dated 31.01.2018.

It is pertinent to mention that a High Court Order on similar issue shall be applicable to all effected People placed similarly due to the replacement scales of 25.02.1999. In this context we wish to draw your kindself's attention to the Judgement of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in State of UP & Othrs VS Arvind Kumar Srivastava & Othrs (CA.No.9849/2014) as extracted below,

“ Normal rule is that when a particular set of employees is given relief by the Court, all other identically situated persons need to be treated alike by extending that benefit. Not doing so would amount to discrimination and would be violative of Article 14 of the Constitution of India. This principle needs to be applied in service matters more emphatically as the service jurisprudence evolved by this Court from time to time postulates that all similarly situated persons should be treated similarly.....”

Sir, we request you to issue clear instructions to stop all Downgradation, Re fixation / Recoveries in the light of CAT orders, High Court Orders and the Hon'ble Supreme Court order on equal treatment for all similarly placed persons. We are also attaching the stay order granted in our case. Thanking you.
