**REQUEST TO STRICTLY ADHERE TO PRASAR BHARATI CIRCULAR DATED
06.08.2020**

Sir,

This is w.r.t convening the long pending PEX DPC and considering the Adhoc & Insitu PEXs to the vacant posts both in DP & DR Quota. In this regard, I wish to extract a para from the circular issued by Prasar Bharati Secretariat on 06.08.2020 (copy attached),

“ Many grievances are being received in Prasar Bharati Secretariat regarding non-adherence to the model calendar for conducting DPCs for various cadres. It is a vital element and is of paramount importance from both the Officers / Employees point of view, as well as from the view of organization for smooth functioning of offices.... Therefore ADGs (Admin Head) of each zone are requested to ensure the timely completion of DPCs of all cadres in prescribed time frame “ (Prasar Bharati circular dated 06.08.2020)

In the above context, I once again wish to request your kindness to **advise the PBRB Cell which has been successfully overcoming legal problems to convene several DPCs in the past few years** to do the needful in this regard. The PEX DPCs have been delayed from 2016 August onwards due to the Judgement of Hon'ble CAT Delhi (dated 24.08.2016) to include the feeder cadres as per the PEX RR Amendment of 31.12.1993. Eventhough that Judgement has been challenged by us in the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi (WP.No.9553/2018) and is listed for Arguments on 07.10.2020, **our Association has no objection to the PEX DPC being convened**. In this regard, we wish to only point out the 2 following points for consideration,

1. The Statutory Rule (PEX Recruitment Rule of 1962) as amended on 23.10.1984 has to be scrupulously followed w.r.t **Variable Ratio (Rule : 4A-e & f)**. This Rule has already attained finality vide the **Supreme Court Order of 14.02.2000** (SLP.No.8880-8881/1999) and has been reiterated by the **Hon'ble CAT Delhi on 21.10.2010** (OA.No.2762 / 2008), **Hon'ble High Court of Jaipur on 05.04.2018** (DB-CWP.13581 & 13583 / 2011), **Hon'ble High Court of Srinagar on 14.02.2019** (SWP.No.798/2015) and once again by the **Hon'ble High Court of Jaipur on 08.05.2019** (DB-WMA.50 / 2019). Any dilution or bypassing of this Rule (4A- & f) **would invite contempt of all the above Hon'ble Court Orders.**

2. I on behalf of all the adhoc & insitu PEXs once again request your kindness to **divert the DR vacancies in PEX Cadre (as already proposed by AIR directorate in 2016**

) , so that the shortage of vacancies in DP quota to accommodate all the TREXs working as insitu PEX is taken care off. The last TREX (recruited by SSC through an All India advertisement who would have joined in 1996) have been languishing without a single promotion for the past 24 years, and hence diversion of DR Quota would resolve the problem of stagnation among all insitu PEXs in one go. We had earlier written several letters on this issue.

All our members are eagerly awaiting this long pending PEX DPCs and all of us are sure that the TEAM under your kindself's guidance and headed by the ADG (HR) would be go by the Rules and be Fair in their decisions.
