Respected Sir,

I wish to bring to your information that there seems to be **misleading campaign as usual from a section of the staff in Doordarshan that the JTS DPC in IBPS cannot be convened** or if at all convened than the results cannot be published as the review DPC in PEX Cadre is not complete. In this context I wish to bring to your kind notice that the Ministry has already approached the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi vide a WP ( No.9577/2019 ) seeking a go ahead for convening the JTS DPC in IBPS and the Hon'ble High Court vide its order dated 02.09.2019 ( copy attached ) has given a go ahead to the Ministry on its petition. Another CM ( No.45049/2019 ) was filed by Doordarshan Production Assistants in a pending WP ( No.9553/2018 ) seeking a stay of the JTS DPC, which was again rejected by the Hon'ble Court on 14.10.2019 ( copy attached ) with a direction that the said DPC shall be subject to the outcome of this case.

**Hence, as on date there is no legal bar against convening the JTS DPC in IBPS or publishing its results .**
