A ONE TIME RELAXATION IN THE PEX / JTS & STS RRs

Sir,

We wish to thank the Ministry for very swiftly processing the JTS (IBPS) DPC proposal in May 2020 and wish to once again highlight the **unique & persisting problem among the Programme cadres in AIR & DD- namely-STAGNATION**. In this regard, your kindself may be aware that Transmission Executives of the 1994 batch and those of the 1988 batches recruited on an All India basis by SSC are still languishing either as a TREX (PEX-insitu) or as PEX and the Programme Executives recruited by UPSC on an All India basis are also languishing from 1984 / 1986 / 1988 as ADPs. In the context of the above problem which is affecting the morale of the programme cadres leading to frustration among them, Content Creation & Programme Administration also suffers. Taking into consideration the above mentioned three problems, i humbly submit to your kindself to allow a one time relaxation in the RR of **Programme Executives (to allow diversion of the DR quota to DP quota)**, the **JTS RR (to divert the 73 DR posts to DP Quota)** and **relaxation in the STS RR to make the eligible service for promotion from JTS to STS as one year regular service**.

All the above mentioned 3 relaxations are issues about which the Ministry is aware of, and the Hon'ble Minister as the ultimate Authority in issuing the said RRs is Competent to relax the said RRs. **The above mentioned 3 steps shall go a long way in improving the functioning of AIR & DD in the context of Content creation**. It will also bring some solace to the serving TREXs & PEXs who have languished without commensurate promotions , inspite of vacancies in the PEX / JTS / STS cadre over the years.
