


We wish to Thank the Chairman, CEO and Member (Personnel) Prasar Bharti for having consistently taken up the issue of stagnation in Programme Cadres, and for having brought out the idea of amending the IBPS RR to provide for promotion to the long suffering PEXs. Prasar Bharti Board in its 125th Meeting on 05.02.2015 and 128th Meeting on 07.09.2015 had considered and approved this relaxation in RR as a way out to improve the overall performance of AIR & DD both on the audience front and the revenue front. This step would motivate the core cadres in AIR & DD responsible for content conceptualisation, creation and scheduling. In this context, we submit the following points for consideration in the course of amending the IBPS RR to make good the enormous levels of stagnation among the programme cadres, where the last regular DPC in JTS Cadre took place 22 years back, and the STS DPC had been convened 12 years back.


1. It is important to correct & reduce the eligible service for promotion from JTS to STS of the Production Cadre in Schedule-V from 5 years to 4 years, as both the Cadres in Schedule – IV & V are equated and belong to the same service. Moreover having two kinds of eligible service for promotion from the same feeder cadres will lead to litigation. The very purpose of the amendment to overcome stagnation among the PEXs shall also be lost due to this dichotomy.
2. We wish to submit that the respective pay scale of the STS cadre may also be corrected in the Amendment by including the existing GP of Rs.6600/- for the Post.

3. The following correction to the Notification is also submitted for consideration.

1	<p>Para.2 of Notification -----</p> <p>-In column 4, S.No.4 of Schedules IV & V of IBPS Recruitment Rules 1990, the existing entry shall be substituted by the following,</p> <p>‘ Officers in JTS with 5 years regular service in the grade in medium in which the vacancy arises, failing which officers in JTS having a combined service of 7 years as JTS and Programme Executive / Equated Categories.</p>	<p>‘ Officers in JTS with 4 years regular service in the grade, failing which officers in JTS having a combined service of 6 years as JTS and Programme Executive / Equated Categories. The Eligible service in JTS cadre shall include adhoc service rendered if any as well.</p> <p>(The above proposed correction is in line with the combined existing eligible service of 4 years for promotion from JTS to STS, and the eligible service of 2 years for Promotion from Rs.4800/- GP (Serving PEXs) to the JTS GP of Rs.5400/- as per the recommendations of the 6th CPC dated 24.03.2009 (No.AB.14017/61/2008-Estt (RR).</p> <p>The above proposal also overcomes the problem of adhoc service rendered in JTS due to non-convening of DPCs for the past 22 years.</p>
